School Supplies List – September 2017

Over the summer break you may be out shopping for the materials that your child will need for the next school year. Please refer to the list below to get you started. Individual teachers will send out a more detailed list in September:

- duotangs (different colours, approximately 5)
- pencils (average of 3 pencils per month, 30 pencils for the year)
- wax crayons (FDK), pencil crayons (Gr. 1-6)
- markers (washable)
- calculator
- erasers (10 for the school year)
- Geometry set (Gr. 5 and 6)
- pencil sharpener (with container for shavings)
- three ring lined paper (Gr. 4 and up)
- pencil case for carrying all supplies
- ruler (at least 5 for the year; they get broken/lost)
- scissors
- glue sticks and/or glue bottle
- box of facial tissue for desk
- combination lock for locker (Gr. 4 and up)



Grade 6 Graduation will take place on Thursday, June 22nd at 10:30 a.m. at the school. We will begin with a prayer service, followed by the ceremony, and students will then go on the Cortina Cruise at 1:30 p.m.. Graduates may invite family members to the ceremony; please note that only Pius Graduates can participate in the Cortina Cruise. Bring your cameras!

When buying pencils, erasers and rulers in multiples, simply send only one at a time to school and store the rest at home; check with your child to monitor the replacement of these supplies. Thank you!

Student Agendas: All students from Grades 1-6 will receive an agenda in September to use throughout the school year – please do not purchase one from a store. Parents are asked to purchase the agenda for \$8 next September. FDK students will use a “Mr. Zippy” (Ziploc bag) to carry notes and letters home and will not be purchasing the agenda book.
